## **FROM THE RECTORY DESK**

Palm Sunday is the start of Holy Week when the season of Lent and self-denial draws to a close and the Easter joy of resurrection life beckons.



For today though we are in hosanna mood and wave our palms in procession to welcome our Christ into Jerusalem. The lengthy passion gospel appointed for today is best read dramatically located as it is in the eucharistic liturgy, no need for a sermon it captures every detail of the journey to the cross.

The Easter Triduum follows with Holy Thursday, a night of betrayal, arrest and foot washing. A day for the blessing of oils and for Christian priests the world over to re-affirm their ministerial vows. Good Friday, the day of Crucifixion and the death of our Lord powerfully re-enacted in the Stations of the Cross, and devotional services. Holy Saturday follows as a vigil day when Jesus descended into hell to proclaim his love to those who lived before his coming. If you count the festival days using the Hebrew calendar, then the Triduum would also include Easter Day and the resplendent glory of a Christus Rex.

Do come and join us as we follow the steps of Jesus through Holy Week to Easter it will be a guaranteed time of humble anointing in the paschal mysteries.

May God grant you a holy and blessed Triduum,
