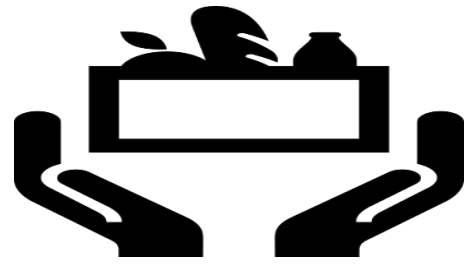

Our Mission and Ministry plan identified the need to support the pastoral mission of the overseas church in ways that would help those who are struggling to cope with everyday life. I am pleased to say that the Barnabas Fund, a charity that is dedicated to supporting persecuted Christians around the world have launched a project called food.gives. This provides churches with the opportunity to donate dried selected foods to our hungry Christian brothers and sisters in places of pressure and persecution. To that end I invite you to think and pray about contributing towards filling a box in each of our churches that we can send monthly to Barnabas Fund who will distribute around the world. The food items they request are:

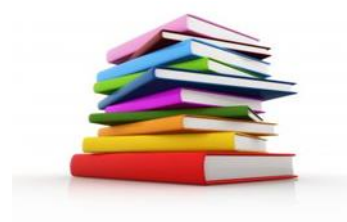
- Wheat flour
- Rice
- Lentils (dried)
- Chick Peas (dried)
- Soap (bars)
- Salt

Please only collect dried food (not tins) and ensure the items do not contain liquid, oil, or animal products. This is a great project and being part of a global food bank is a wonderful way in which we can connect with other Christians and share our love and generosity with them in practical ways that will help them to cope with challenging and difficult times.

REMEMBER HELP US TO HELP YOU WHEN ATTENDING CHURCH IN PERSON BY OBSERVING THE FOLLOWING:

- Sanitise on arrival and departure
- Always wear a mask
- Give your contact details when asked
- Sit in the areas marked with red and white tape as directed by the Churchwardens and stay there until the service ends
- Do not gather in groups before, during or after worship
- Do not gather outside the churches for social conversation
- Do not sing or hum with the music even if tempted to do so you will spread the virus if you are contagious and will not be aware of that if you are asymptomatic.
- When you make your responses do not shout or speak loudly
- Drop your offering in the church plate on departure • Keep to the maximum attendance of thirty.

3. Set up a monthly standing order to the above bank account. Michael will supply you with a Gift Aid form for any payments which you are kind enough to make.
