FROM THE RECTORY DESK

Dear Friends,

The past few weeks have been busy as we target funds to support Mission and Ministry. We are grateful to those who organised Concerts, Bric-a-Brac and a



wonderful Christmas Fair. Every pound will help us sustain the future of our churches and keep ministry solidly represented at a time when so many parishes are being dissolved or passed over to larger parishes.

We have several projects to complete in the new year including the Clock at Seale church which requires a new winding mechanism at a cost of £2340 plus vat for a manual system double that for an automatic system.

The floodlighting at Seale church is expensive to run and we are exploring eco friendly lighting which will be less expensive long term. The retaining wall on the East end of the churchyard will require extensive repair and tenders are out for this specialist work. The exposed wall at Puttenham church requires safety fencing and work to the tracery window and tower pointing needs urgent attention.

We appreciate any help that we can receive for maintenance work on any of the above projects from our church FRIENDS and by any donations that you may feel inspired to give.

Finally, our theme of waiting during Advent is picked up with John the Baptist who came expecting the Messiah and called the people to prepare to receive him. May our hearts be filled with excited preparation as we await his second coming and the celebration of his physical birth at Christmas.
