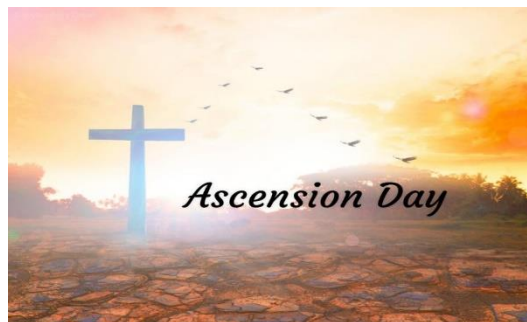
Prayer for this week
