FROM THE RECTORY DESK

Dear Friends,

It is an essential mystery within the doctrines of our Christian faith to celebrate the fact that we worship one God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, in so doing we may be misunderstood by less discerning people, but we are uniquely placed to experience the blessings of the Holy Trinity having been created within the bounds of such a fellowship since the beginning of time.



A communal Godhead in a relationship of divine love, what else could serve so meaningfully as a model for family life? and an example of how we relate to one another in friendship and community.

You will not find the word Trinity in the Bible, yet all our great Anglican liturgies are permeated with trinitarian thinking and expression and direct us to a deep sense of reciprocal blessings and grace as we worship in the context of the body of Christ. We don't have to be theologically sharp to understand the significance of the Holy Trinity, in fact the deeper theologians dig into it the more complex it becomes.

There is much to be said for keeping things simple, perhaps even to the level of St. Patrick's shamrock.

MEMORIAL FLOWERS SPONSORSHIP AT SEALE CHURCH
