Dear Friends,


The recent earthquake on the Turkish/Syrian border has yet again revealed just how devastating acts of nature can be with the




death toll exceeding 24, 000 and many more people injured and still trapped in the rubble. Our hearts go out to the victims as the world rallies to come to their aid. There are a number of collection points for clothing and other vital supplies that have been set up, in the local communities. Some have by now become overwhelmed with donations, so you may need to check around where clothing is still being accepted. The clothing is essential to protect people from winter night temperatures of minus 13.

There are several international appeals for aid including UNICEF and the British Red Cross who are already deployed in the earthquake zone. Our prayers for the families of the dead and wounded not forgetting the rescue workers fighting against time to pull people from the debris.


