Dear Friends,

Saint George is soundly rooted in English history, very popular with English kings especially Edward 1st whose military standards carried the red cross on a white background. He is said to have owned a relic of the blood of Saint George, King Edward 3rd made him patron of the newly founded Most Noble Order of the Garter.



He is cited in Shakespeare's Henry 5th during the battle of Harfleur "Once more unto the breach dear friends, God for Harry! England and saint George' he was hailed at the British army retreat from the battle of Mons. St. Georges chapel Windsor is said to have kept remains of the saint.

George never visited England his personal history points to a noble Roman officer who was executed under the persecutions against Christians in 303 by the emperor Diocletian. George is a Christian martyr worthy of celebrating his reputation for virtue and holiness has spread across the world and his sainthood for England has been remembered since the 9th century, his patronal day is 23rd April.
