FROM THE RECTORY DESK

Dear Friends,

We are on the threshold of crowning our new king and our services next week will celebrate Charles 3rd in that role. The churches will be open for prayer and the lighting of candles on Friday and



Saturday and there will be a congratulations book available for your comments and prayers. Following the Act of Supremacy, church and crown have historically been a strong partnership so please remember the significant role King Charles 3rd will undertake as "Defender of the Faith" and "Supreme Governor" of the Church of England. As the Supreme Governor the monarch appoints senior members of the church in the role of Bishops etc. the process involves the Crown Nominations Commission and the Prime Minister. The preface to the 39 articles of religion underpins the importance of both titles for the serving monarch:

Being by God's Ordinance, according to Our just Title, Defender of the Faith and Supreme Governor of the Church, within these Our Dominions, We hold it most agreeable to this Our Kingly Office, and Our own religious zeal, to conserve and maintain the Church committed to Our Charge, in Unity of true Religion, and in the Bond of Peace ... We have therefore, upon mature Deliberation, and with the Advice of so many of Our Bishops as might conveniently be called together, thought fit to make this Declaration following ... That We are Supreme Governor of the Church of England ...

Our prayers for King Charles 3rd that with God's help he may carry out his ecclesiastical responsibilities with courage, discernment and unswerving loyalty to the Christian Faith, following the example of his Mother the late Queen Elizabeth 2nd.
