#### FROM THE RECTORY DESK

Last Friday at Alpha we zoomed in on the importance of the Bible in the lives of Christian believers. Still the bestselling book well above Lord of the Rings and Harry Potter more and more people around the world want a copy of this life changing tome containing 66 other books that inspire and enlighten in so many ways.

The Holy Bible is simply essential reading if we are to receive God's revelations to us and to grow in our knowledge and wisdom and in the truth of his salvation plan for the world.

There are so many different versions available that it can get a little confusing, but I would commend the NIV and the ESV versions as easy reading with scholarly textual interpretations. You can also get a one-year bible and numerous aps for a digital version. The Old King James version remains a bible of poetic beauty but of course it pre-dates the discovery of the dead sea scrolls at Qumran.

This amazing find revealed many fragments of other gospel sources all of which scholars regard as important but not as primacy scripture of 1<sup>st</sup> canon order.

I invite you to join us every last Wednesday of the month at the Sands church as we explore informally the scriptures together. We are currently working through the gospel of John and discovering many blessings as we read.
