It was a challenging time yet we recorded record numbers of people and children worshipping with us. We give thanks to God for his blessings on our efforts.



In January we adjust to the new pattern of services consisting of a 9 am and 10:30 am with evening compline by zoom. These changes are necessary to allow us to staff our services and continue with musical provision, they will also significantly help us to reduce our costly energy footprint, heating four churches that can have few people attending. We will benefit from a stronger sense of being a gathered united parish community and enjoy the fellowship that will bring. We shall be adding a monthly allage service at 3:30pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month which will boost our outreach to younger families.
